SUMMER 2020 COURSE OFFERINGS

Hispanic Arts and Crafts

Instructor: Ms. Williams Students in Grades 5-12

Session One: July 13-17 and/or Session Two: July 20-24

In this week-long course, students will create a variety of Hispanic arts and crafts. This is a hands-on course in which students will produce their own artistic products while also learning about the cultures associated with these handicrafts. Each day, students will leave class with new items they have created, in addition to developing and deepening their understanding of the cultural perspectives and practices related to those products. Students will learn about celebrations such as the Day of the Dead and Alasitas and will create crafts such as *papel picado* or cut-out paper, Guatemalan kite crafts, sugar skulls, and panpipes. Students interested in this course should plan to show up each day ready to explore new cultures and create new things. No prior experience in Spanish or Art is required for this course.

Painting Studio

Instructor: Mr. Walker Students in Grades 5-12

Session One: July 13-17 and/or Session Two: July 20-24

Students of all levels of experience will expand on their Visual Art skills while exploring large-scale acrylic painting in this fun and informative studio workshop. Each student will be working with easy to learn steps to take their ideas from tiny sketches to mural sized compositions with confidence. Students will enjoy learning a variety of application techniques to incorporate with their own style and creativity as they compose their own large-scale, 4' x 4' painting.

Photography

Instructor: Ms. Grez Students in Grades 5-12 Session One: July 13-17

In this week-long course, students will learn the basics of digital photography including lighting, composition, and editing. The course starts with a general overview of the different types of cameras including their components and features. After the students have a general idea on what the different settings do, they will have plenty of time to practice taking pictures indoors and outdoors. Students will have the opportunity to work with a variety of subjects such as landscapes and portraiture. The week will end with a group display that will showcase each student's creativity. Students will need to have their own digital camera with a USB cable or a card reader.

Woodworking

Instructor: Mr. Howard Students in Grades 5-12 Session One: July 13-17

When was the last time you put something on a table or a bookcase, or sat on a bench? Did you stop to think about how that table, bookcase, or bench was made? If you did, great! This course is for you! If not, that's ok-this course will help you appreciate the craftsmanship in the furniture around you. Using reclaimed wood and hand tools, we will tackle some basic carpentry projects. Sign-up for this course to enjoy a fun-filled week of working with your hands, and go home with a functional piece of furniture that you can be proud of. Get your hammer ready!

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Please note that these workshops are independent summer courses; there is not a full-service summer camp at the school. Participants need to bring snacks and lunch each day. Interested students are encouraged to apply quickly, as the number of participants in each course is **limited**.
