Wednesday, January 25: There will be a Parent Information Meeting at 6:00 pm for parents/guardians of grade 8 students who will be traveling to Italy this spring.


**Thursday, January 26:** There will be a virtual information session at 7:00 pm for Upper School families to learn more about Title I targeted support at the Upper School.
