September 13, 2023

MEETING NOTES

Head of School Mr. O'Keefe opened the meeting at 6:30pm with Interim Principal/Asst Head of School Ms. Williams at Rising Tide with 20+ parents in person and on zoom. We went around the table and around the zoom, introducing ourselves, including the age of students at Rising Tide.

Old Business

Parent Wendy Marshall pointed out that Parent Group is not an independent entity or a fundraising group for Rising Tide. Parent Group gets donations as needed for activities to support students or the school. Having said that, parent Martha Dennison reported that the Group does have \$1102 on account from last year, where some solicitation requests raised more than was needed for the current activity. That money is earmarked to support those traditions this year.

New Business

Administration Update

Mr. O'Keefe provided an update on the 25th anniversary events scheduled for late September.

- **9/28 Gala**. Organized by the Board, parents are invited to purchase tickets to enjoy an adults-only celebration with cocktails, heavy appetizers, and games of chance. Ticket information in the Monday Memo. Parents are invited to donate gift cards for the prizes and/or donate cash in lieu of purchasing tix. Students are encouraged to provide artwork to decorate the Jones River Trading Post for the party. - **9/30 Family Event**. The School is organizing a free family 'backyard barbecue' with DJ and fun activities. Students will be involved in planning the event's activities. Mr. O'Keefe was invited to provide an update on the 2023-24 school year. Highlights included:

- Leadership team changes have been made to reflect a whole school enrollment of ~625 students. The current team one Head of School and one Interim Principal/Asst Head of School overseeing both schools and assisting with curriculum development with an Assistant Principal at each school provides a cohesive and lean leadership structure.
- **Ms. Zahra Williams**, Interim Principal and Asst Head of School, introduced herself to the group, providing info on her background and extensive experience at RT. In addition to a strong curriculum foundation, her goals for the year are to ensure everyone feels safe and supported while we bring joy back to teaching and learning.
- A parent asked about the **Upper School schedule change** Ms. Wiliams explained the new schedule is fixed (vs rotating, as prior years) with a rotating Academic Support block on

Mon, Tue & Thu that allows teachers to focus on building specific skills with their students to fill learning gaps and ensure long-term student success. On Fridays, students can choose which class to seek Academic Support; there is no Academic Support block on Wednesdays (due to ½ day.)

- A parent asked about COVID policies Mr. O'Keefe said that state education officials have been prescriptive to encourage schools to focus on in-person school with home support for students who may test positive for COVID. There are no plans for expanding virtual school opportunities at this time.
- A parent asked about Google classroom for tracking assignments Ms. Williams confirmed that all teachers are using Google classroom, although there is some variation in the ways that they may use it at this time.
- Ms. Williams announced that 'Grade Push-out' will be introduced the week of 9/25. On a bi-weekly basis, student grades will be published on the community portal for students and parents to get a 'snapshot' of current student performance. More info on grade pushout will be provided in the Monday Memo and at Parent Open House on Thursday, 9/21.

Class Parent Ambassadors

Mr. O'Keefe introduced a 'job description' for a new parent role at Rising Tide, created to work with the Deans of Community to assist in communication and support for parents. Parent Ambassadors will be assigned for each grade (e.g., senior class, class of 2024) and will:

- Look for opportunities to bring people together within the grade level
- Communicate with administration on questions, ideas, and concerns from grade level families
- Reinforce information on events, initiatives, and processes
- Support RTCPS' marketing by sharing grade-level stories that celebrate and honor the diversity and experiences of families in our community.
- Provide coordination assistance with grade-level enrichment opportunities
